

HOUSE RULES

Firstly, and most importantly, please remember this Respite home is used regally to give Respite Breaks to children with disabilities, please respect and look after the home at all times.

Please read these rules carefully. We want you to enjoy yourselves and be safe. Please leave the holiday home how you found it so the next visitor can have the same enjoyable experience that you have had. This document forms part of the Holiday Homes Terms & Conditions Thank you.

1. **Have fun and enjoy yourselves, that's what you're here for.**
2. **NO SMOKING/VAPING inside the holiday home.**
3. Keep the holiday home clean and tidy
4. Please clean up all spillages immediately to avoid staining.
5. Do not remove items from the holiday home.
6. All breakages must be replaced with the same item.
7. Do not take holiday home furniture out onto the veranda.
8. Be aware that radiators get hot, take care with children.
9. Be aware that in wet weather the veranda may be slippery.
10. Remove muddy or wet shoes before entering the holiday home.
11. Keep the caravan locked and safe, close all windows when going out.
12. Any gas, water or electric problems report immediately (see emergency contact numbers).
13. Never leave the gas cooker on or unattended when going out.
14. In the event of lost keys report to Crackerjacks immediately, there will be a charge for new keys to be cut of £100.00, this will be taken from your deposit.
15. Please respect your neighbours and keep noise to a minimum at night.
16. Only people that have checked in with Crackerjacks are permitted to stay in the holiday home. (See T/C Sleeping Arrangements)
17. Please **DO NOT** put BBQs on the veranda. BBQs must be sighted on the patio area to avoid damage or fire.
18. Be aware of moving vehicles on the site, EG: grass cutting, dustbin vehicles and service vehicles.
19. Please abide by the holiday parks rules and regulations at all times.
20. **STRICTLY NO ANIMALS.**
21. Please supervise your children at all times and **don't** allow them to climb on the veranda fencing. Make sure they are familiar with your location if allowing them to go and play. They are your responsibility,
